Two sessions are scheduled each with two evening classes (6:30 to 9:00 pm)

Session 1 will meet **Thursday July 5th & July 12th**
Session 2 will meet **Thursday Aug 2nd & Aug 9th**

Scouts must attend both classes in the same session,

You **must** arrive with a Merit Badge Book, a Blue Card signed by your Scoutmaster, pencils, paper and any materials required for the merit badge. A merit badge work book will be very helpful. **A \$5.00 donation for the Church is requested for each session.** This will be collected for the church for the use of their facilities. Your parent / guardian must sign you in and out of every session day.
